PART - A

The outcome achieved of the Plan of Action for 2012-2013.

1. Construction of buildings: Request has been made to the state government to hasten the much awaited construction of new buildings. The state government did its best, and actual construction works has begun in May 2012, with a work schedule of 18 months. However, the State PWD department is the monitoring department and the college authority has no say in the construction process, except to make suggestions for improvement etc. The college building committee has been entrusted to look after the work progress, and to check and verify materials used. Construction of most of the buildings has been started and materials used are regularly checked by the said committee.

Regarding construction of standard Women's Hostel, construction work has not been resumed as no more installment of the remaining fund is received following submission of the Utilization Certificate. However, 36 lakhs out of 40 lakh of the approved amount has been received and utilized. The construction is at its final stage of preparing partition wall and room allotment only.

- 2. **Study tours:** Study tour has been organized for students of Geography to visit Serlui B hydro-power project.
- 3. **Research work/ Further studies:** The importance of research works and further studies have been stressed at the re-opening of the college in the staff meeting.
- Fund for more books: The College has tried to acquire adequate books for academic purposes, and through UGC funding, some quantity of books could be purchased for immediate requirement.
- 5. Adequate teaching staff: State government (through Directorate of H & TE) has been requested again and again to provide adequate teaching faculty for the college. As a result some teachers have been appointed in the much needed departments.

$\underline{PART - B}$

1. Activities reflecting the goals and objectives of the institution.

The goals and objectives may be put under two main heads: making and maintaining buildings/rooms to accommodate students of various disciplines, and to give the kind of education to students in line with the name of the department – Human Resources Development.

(a) **Buildings**:

(i) Construction of Women's Hostel, which was started on 3.5.2010 under UGC fund, the total estimate accepted being Rs.41,00,000/-, the first installment amounting to Rs.20,00,000/- has already been received in the preceding year, and the second installment of Rs 16,00,000/- is received this year, and about 80% the work is being finished. Inspecting team from UGC has been entertained and the report thereof

has been submitted to UGC. The remaining balance of grant is still in wait.

(ii) Proposal and estimate for Major reconstruction of the main building (Class rooms) amounting to Rs.10.75 crores has been submitted and was earnestly be pursued to the Govt. of Mizoram.

Of the estimated amount of Rs.10.75 crores, Rs.951.29 lakhs has been approved, and work is being carried on from May, 2012. The buildings included are – Administrative & Library Buildings, Arts & Commerce Buildings, Sciences & Computer Sciences Buildings, Multipurpose Hall, Staff Quarters, Women hostel and Boys Hostels. The construction work is slated to be completed within 18 months. The construction work could not be completed within the stipulated schedule and work schedule was extended for another six months. Meanwhile, utmost care is taken by the College Building committee in looking after the work process. Wooden windows were changed to aluminium framed windows at the request of the committee. Some of the materials were also being complained about and has been replaced.

(b) Quality Education;

In order to achieve academic excellence, the affiliating University viz., Mizoram University, has introduced semester system of education from the previous year. To pass on from annual to semester system, the academic committee of the college has chalked out various plans and actions.

- (i) Academic Routine: The committee prepared and listed out various academic routines such as date for internal examinations, date for submission of assignment, internal & university examinations invigilation schedule and preparation of college prospectus.
- (ii) One-day workshop: In order to promote academic-related environment and internet culture among students and staff alike, the IQAC in collaboration with NIELIT, Aizawl Centre jointly organized a one-day cyber security awareness campaign for students and staff, on 4th Dec, 2013. The programme outline is

(iii) State Level Seminar: State Level Seminar on "Teaching Techniques of Mizo Poetry" was jointly organized by Govt Champhai College and Department of Mizo, Pachhunga University College on 4th Dec., 2013. The seminar was sponsored by Building and other Construction welfare board, Department of Labour, Employment and Industrial Training, Govt of Mizoram.

Shri C. Lalsiamthanga, HOD, Dept of Mizo, Govt Champhai College presented the paper "Method of Teaching Poetry".
